

# WOOD SAVER'S™

If you have a Bradley Smoker®, one of the most important accessories for you is our *NEW* “**WOOD SAVER'S™**”. Ultra Industries has looked at what we could do to improve your smoking experience. We have made our new product to help you save wood. If you have a Bradley Smoker® you know you can never use those last two Bisquettes®, and one of them always gets burnt a little. Ultra Industries solution is easy, just put some of our **WOOD SAVER'S™** in your smoker when you are ready to finish up smoking. The smoker uses the **WOOD SAVER'S™** instead of the last three Bisquettes®. It will save you time in cleanup, and Money in wasted wood. And give you a better tasting smoke because it puts that last Bisquettes® into the water pan were it belongs. ## Instructions: \*\*

- 1.) Load the wood you need for the time you are going to smoke, go to step 2.) (~1 every 20 min., or ~3 Bisquettes® per Hour).  
Example: 4 hours x 3 = ~12 Bisquettes®

If you don't know how long your going to smoke load your wood, & smoke.  
After you have loaded the last of your wood go to step 2.)

- 2.) After you have loaded your wood place your **WOOD SAVER'S™** on top of your wood just like you added three more Bisquettes®.
- 3.) Finish up your smoking.
- 4.) Turn smoker off.
- 5.) Unplug smoker from electrical source.
- 6.) Allow smoker to cool before starting clean up.
- 7.) **Recommended procedure for removing WOOD SAVER'S™ from smoker.**  
Remove Cooking Racks, & Drip Tray. Remove Drip/Water/Waste Pot (the bowl that burnt wood falls in to). Clean bowl. Put cold water in bowl, & place bowl back in smoker. (Make sure you have completed step 5.) Take a utensil (example tongs) and slide **WOOD SAVER'S™** into bowl of cold water. Allow plenty of time to cool before handling.

### WARNING :

**DO NOT** HANDLE **WOOD SAVER'S™** OR ANTHING HOT WITH YOUR BARE HANDS. Handling **WOOD SAVER'S™** before they have cooled will result in a BURN. Depending on the temperature burns can be severe. Placing **WOOD SAVER'S™** on a combustibile material could result in burning, melting, scorching, or scarring of that surface. The **WOOD SAVER'S™** are made of thick aluminum, & will remain HOT longer then the other parts of your smoker. Just like putting a skillet or heavy pot in an oven, the **WOOD SAVER'S™** will take quite some time to cool down. **WOOD SAVER'S™** will be hotter then the interior of the smoker because they are on or near the Bisquette Burner (heat sores that burns the wood).

- 8.) Clean **WOOD SAVER'S™** just like you do the rest of your smoker parts. **WOOD SAVER'S™** can be placed in the silverware compartment of your dishwasher. Make sure that **WOOD SAVER'S™** are clean and dry before you put them away. Following all of these steps should allow you to get many years of joy from your **WOOD SAVER'S™**.

\*\* Read your Bradley Smoker® Owners Manual and familiarize yourself with its operation before using **WOOD SAVER'S™**. Always follow safe operating procedures.
